English

This term in Literacy we will be focusing on listening and speaking skills, through storytelling, role-play and drama. We will be writing around our story focusing on character, setting and sequence. We will review single letter sounds and how to build words. We will practise our pencil grip and letter formation, writing sentences with gaps between words, and using phonics to spell.

Science

This term in Science we will identify and name a variety of common animals. We will describe and compare common animals and discover if they are carnivore, herbivore or omnivore. Our ongoing theme is observing the changing seasons.

PE

We will be able to get dressed and undressed by ourselves. Our PE focus will be movement and coordination through games and activities.

This term in Maths we will count, read and write numbers from 0-20 in numerals and words. We will develop our confidence with numbers to 100 and understand the signs +, - and =. We will recognise and use words related to dates e.g. days of the week, months and years.

Music

We will listen to a range of music and describe what we like or don't like. We will learn the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch.

Geography


We will practise using compass directions to direct a pirate to treasure, and use maps to explore the school. We will also develop our locational awareness within the UK.

Art & Design

This term in Art we will explore primary colours using different mediums. We will investigate the use of these colours and spot them in the school and surrounding areas.

RE
