- Use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram

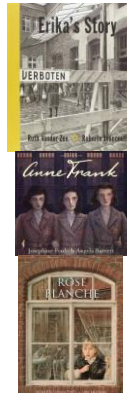
