PE

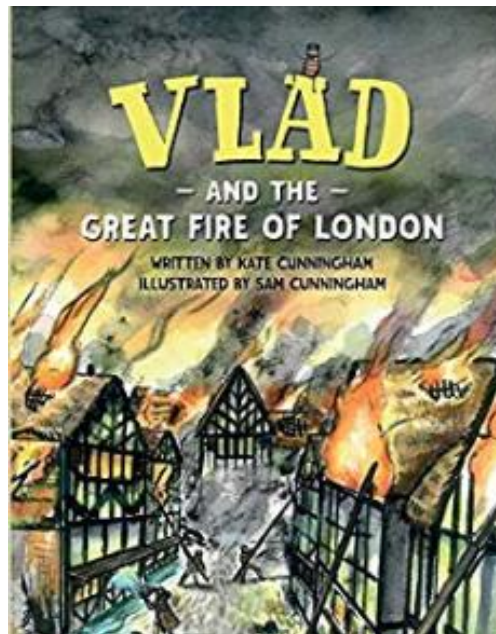
In PE this term we will also begin developing our throwing and catching skills, as well following and rolling. We will also be learning to play some team ball games to build our coordination and agility.
