Focus Song: Blackbird

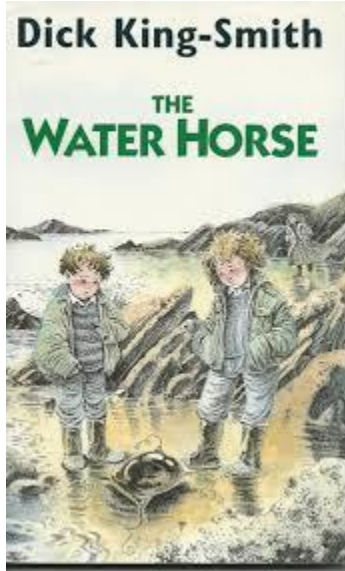
