

**Curriculum Map  
Year 5  
Term 6 2021**

**English**

In English, this term we will be looking at water worlds. Our book will be *The Huntress Sea* by Sarah Driver. We will explore the world that she has created and use it to inspire our own writing.

For poetry, this term we will be looking at a range of poems from different anthologies.

**Art and Design**

This term we will be doing a textiles project based around 'felt making'.

**Maths**

- Decimals (adding & subtracting decimals, decimal sequences, multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000)
- Geometry and property of shapes
- Measurement and conversion of units

**Science**

Our Science topic for this term is 'Living things'. We will be using this as an opportunity to explore plant life in detail.

**PE**

For PE this term we will be doing mixture of summer sports, including striking and fielding team sports (rounders, cricket etc).

**PSHE**

In PSHE this term we will be continuing to look at relationships alongside e-safety and other stand alone lessons on moral dilemmas.

**Geography**

In Geography we will be looking at rivers. We will use maps and atlases to locate rivers across the UK and the rest of the world. We will also be learning about local rivers and their habitats.
