## English

**Fiction** - *The Wild Folk* by Sylvia V. Linsteadt

## Maths

We will be consolidating the Year 6 maths curriculum through the use of three themed projects which will revisit many of the skills in Key Stage 2.

## Geography

Conservation - the effects of climate change.

We will focus on specific examples where human action has affected the environment e.g. coral reefs and biodiversity in the ocean.

We will examine what can be done to tackle climate change and its effects.

## RE

The children will be carrying out independent research projects about a faith of their choice. We will be consolidating some of the themes taught throughout Year 6.
