My Heart is a Compass

English

This term in English we will be focusing on listening and speaking skills, through storytelling, role-play and drama. We will be writing around our story focusing on character, setting and sequence.

We will review single letter sounds and how to build words. We will practise our pencil grip and letter formation, writing sentences with gaps between words, and using phonics to spell.

Maths

This term in Maths we will count, read and write numbers from 0-20 in numerals and words. We will develop our confidence with numbers to 100 and understand the signs +, - and =. We will recognise and use words related to dates e.g. days of the week, months and years.

Music

We will listen to a range of music and describe what we like or don't like. We will learn to find the pulse of a simple song.

Science

This term in Science we will identify and name a variety of common animals. We will describe and compare common animals and discover if they are carnivore, herbivore or omnivore. Our ongoing theme is observing the changing seasons.


Geography

Art & Design

This term in Art we will explore primary colours using different mediums. We will investigate the use of these colours and spot them in the school and surrounding areas.

Languages

Basic greetings in languages spoken in the class.
