**English**

**Fiction:** Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura  
We will use this text to introduce letter writing.

**Non-fiction:** Instruction writing linked to our Stone Age topic.

**Grammar:** Recap nouns, expanded noun phrases and basic punctuation.

**Maths**


Areas of focus this term include:

- Place Value (2 Weeks)
- Addition and subtraction (4 Weeks)
- Times tables (Multiplication and division facts)

**Reminder:** Children are expected to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables by the end of Year 3.

**Science Focus: Rocks**

To recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.  
To compare and group together different kinds of rocks.  
To describe in simple terms how fossils are formed.

**Religion:** Hinduism.

**Big question:** Would celebrating Diwali at home and in the community bring a feeling of belonging to a Hindu child?
