English

Fiction – Narrative: Writing outcome: Character description

Writing Skills Focus: Rocket Phonics-Appling phonetic skills, basic grammar-past tense, and basic punctuation.

Maths

Number and place value (Week 1-3). Recognise the place value of each digit up to 3-digit numbers. Count in steps of 2, 5 and 10 from any given number.

Addition and Subtraction (Week 4-7): Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently and derive and use related facts up to a 100. Solve problems with addition and subtraction.

We will be learning about tempo, rhythm and pitch through song and poetry. The children will listen to and compare different styles of British music.

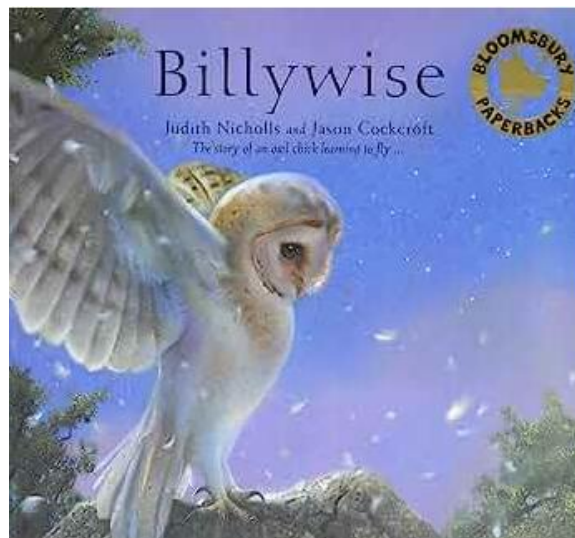
Focus Song: Hands, Feet, Heart
