English

Fiction: Stone Age Boy by *Satoshi Kitamura*
We will use this text as springboard for our letter writing.
Non-fiction: Instruction writing linked to our Stone Age topic.
Grammar: Recap nouns, verbs and basic sentence punctuation.
Phonics: Continue with Rocket Phonics Programme.

Maths

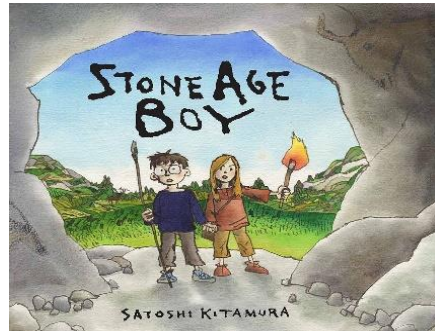
Areas of focus this term include:

- Place Value (2 Weeks)
- Addition and subtraction (4 Weeks)
- Times tables (Multiplication and division facts).

Reminder: Children are expected to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables by the end of Year 3.

Science Focus: Rocks

To recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.
To compare and group together different kinds of rocks.
To describe in simple terms how fossils are formed.

Religion: Hinduism.

Big question: Would celebrating Diwali at home and in the community bring a feeling of belonging to a Hindu child?

Topic: History

The Stone Age Period:

- When was the Stone Age?
- What was Stone Age life like?
- How do historians find out about the past? (evidence)
